Those competitors lacking these must purchase temporary memberships before being allowed to show.

Photocopies of all memberships must be attached to each entry form.

Passports with 2009 Horse License stickers are required for all core Hunter, Jumper and Equitation classes.

## Stabling New for 2009

- **Stabling requests must be in writing and made 2 weeks prior to each show.**
- **Stall fees are non-refundable and all fees must be paid to remain in good standing.**
- **Cost of stabling is to be consistent at each facility but each show may set its own stabling cost.**
- **Cost of bedding is in addition to the stabling cost.**
- **Stabling will only be on a per event basis, no day stalls will be available.**
- **Each facility will make its stabling costs available before the deadline for booking stalls.**

## ARTICLE G111 PONY MEASUREMENT

1. EC officials will conduct random measurement of ponies during the competition year, regardless of whether or not a pony has a permanent measurement card.
2. Ponies six years and over that have been officially measured in this process will be issued a measurement card that is valid for three years. The first three-year cards will be issued in 2009.
3. Ponies under six years of age must be measured annually and will be issued a temporary measurement form. (See Section A, General Regulations, Article A1104)
4. All ponies entered in a national final (e.g. The Royal Horse Show) will be measured at that competition if they do not have a valid current measurement card. To be exempt from measurement at the final, the owner must present the current measurement card. No measurement card dated earlier than 2009 will be accepted.
5. Ponies may be measured barefoot or shod. If shod, the depth of the shoe shall be noted on the measurement page and subtracted from the height. (See A1109.2)

## Official Equine Canada Statement

These Trillium Horse Shows are a recognized Provincial Circuit of equine Canada and are governed by the rules of Equine Canada.

### Equine Canada Statement of Principle

- Equine Canada (EC), the National Federation of Canada supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.
- EC is committed to:
- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors, and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging the routine inspection and consultation with healthcare professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards or nutrition, health comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners and trainers to know and follow their sanctioning organizations rules and to work within the industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.
- The standards by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Except as specified in this program, every class herein is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the said rule book. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rule book, they shall be referred to the Organizing Committee and their decision will be final. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse entry cancel, postpone or re-schedule any class or condition they deem reasonable.
2. The Organizing Committee shall comprise: the judge, steward, and the show manager.
3. All Core Trillium Circuit classes. Participants must be paid up members of the Trillium Hunter Jumper Association, the Ontario Equestrian Federation and at least a SILVER Equine Canada sport license. All horses used in any core classes Hunter, Jumper and Equitation, must have Current, up-to-date passport with a 2009 license sticker.
4. Competitors riding in non-core divisions: Beginner Hunter, Novice Child/Adult Hunter, Training Hunter and Pony Pleasure Hack must be members of both the Ontario Equestrian Federation and the Trillium Hunter Jumper Association, and must also have at least BRONZE Equine Canada sport license
5. The Person Responsible is the individual responsible and accountable for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse. The Person Responsible may be the

trainer or may be an owner, rider, driver, agent or coach. The Person Responsible must be an adult and must hold an EC individual or group license (see A203.5)

6. **Stabling requests must be in writing and made 2 weeks prior to each show. Stall fees are non refundable and all fees must be paid to remain in good standing.**
  - a. **Cost of stabling is to be consistent at each facility but each show may set its own stabling cost.**
  - b. **Cost of bedding is in addition to the stabling cost.**
  - c. **Stabling will only be on a per event basis, no day stalls will be available.**
7. There will be limited stabling available, not necessarily on the show grounds and this only if the secretary is contacted early.
8. **Closing date for entries will be 1 week prior to each show. Post entries may be accepted at the discretion of show management and will be subject to a \$5.00 post entry fee per division/class.** Entries to be faxed to the appropriate show office.
9. All entry forms must have proper signatures, complete Addresses, EC/OEF/THJA numbers for owners and rider(s) and passport numbers for horses. Proof of memberships and passports must be presented at the time of registration. Failure to produce these will result in disqualification. Competitors under 18 years of age must have a parent's or guardian's signature on their entry form. As a result of new helmet regulations, parent and/or legal guardian signatures only are acceptable.
10. A photocopy of all memberships and licenses must be left at the show office at the first show you compete in.
11. Entries must be accompanied by either cash (in full) or by an open cheque at the time of entry.
12. If proof of membership is not provided, competitors will be able to compete only after completion of all appropriate membership forms and deposit of a cheque(s) for the full amount of all memberships.
13. **Points for Year end Championships and Awards will only be accrued after proof of all (EC, OEF, THJA and Passport) numbers have been provided to the show office.**
14. Entry fee refunds must be authorized by the Organizing Committee and/or a veterinarian.
15. The Judge's decision is final.
16. Age divisions are as follows:
  - a. **Adult (Senior)** from the beginning of the calendar year you turn 19. (For 2009 born in 1990 or earlier)
  - b. **Junior "A"** from the beginning of the calendar year in which you reach the age of 16 to the end of the year in which you turn 18. (For 2009 if born in 1991, 1992, 1993)
  - c. **Junior "B"** from the beginning of the calendar year in which you reach the age of 13 to the end of the year in which you turn 15. (For 2009 if born in 1994, 1995, 1996)
  - d. **Junior "C"** until the end of the year in which you turn 12 (For 2009 born in 1997 or later.)
17. All riders must wear approved protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet at all times while riding anywhere on the competition grounds at all Equine Canada sanctioned competitions.
18. All Junior competitors must wear approved head gear with harness fastened for the jog.

19. Approved headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) standards and Displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British Standard BSI, is also acceptable.
20. Senior riders entering into Amateur classes must possess a current EC amateur card.
21. Ponies may only be ridden by Junior riders. Junior 'A' riders may only ride "A" (large) ponies
22. Adult Amateur riders may ride "A" ponies in Adult Amateur classes, BUT ONLY if no Junior is showing the pony.
23. Protests must be made within 48 hours of the occurrence, to the secretary or the Organizing Committee. Protests must be in writing, signed and with a \$ 50.00 deposit. The deposit will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
24. In Hunter Divisions, competitors must complete at least one Over Fences Class to be eligible for the corresponding Hunter Under Saddle Class.
25. Hors Concours entries. Once a horse has shown hors concours it may not compete in any division, Hors concours entries are not permitted in Hunter Divisions (article G501) Hors Concours entries are permitted at the discretion of the organizing committee in the jumper divisions (article G601) .
26. At the discretion of the Organizing Committee, competitors may be required to ride the over fences portion of the hunter division back-to-back.
27. Championship points for the divisions to which they apply will be available at the secretary's booth. Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded after each division.
28. All dogs on the show grounds must be kept under control, preferably on a leash.
29. Proof of a negative Coggins test taken within the past six months must accompany entries or be presented at the time of registration.
30. Entries in the Training Hunter may enter the core classes and divisions only if they are in possession of the a appropriate memberships, licenses and passports with valid horse license stickers.
31. Eligibility in the non-core divisions is as follows:
  - a. **Beginner Division:** Open to riders not showing at more than 2' at the current show.
  - b. **Novice Child/Adult Hunter**, open to riders not showing at heights >2'9" at the current show. Horse/Rider combinations in this division may cross enter into the Training Hunter Division BUT they may not enter the Modified Child/Adult Hunter Division or any other core division over fences at the same show.
  - c. **Training Hunter**, not eligible to show at heights greater than 3'.
32. **Modified Child/Adult Hunter**, horse rider combinations may not show at heights >2'9" at the current show. Riders competing in this division may not show in any other over fences division other than the Training Hunter Division. The top 7 competitors in this division are eligible to compete in the Modified Child/Adult Division at the 2009 Trillium Championships
33. **Modified Child/Adult Medal**, riders may not show in their age appropriate (Adult, A,B,C) equitation over fences.
  - a. The 7 qualifiers in the over fences class are eligible to compete in the Modified Child/Adult Medal at the 2008 Trillium Championships.
  - b. NB: Riders may not cross enter into any other over fences division (apart from Training Hunter Division) or class at the same show.

33. **ARTICLE G111 PONY MEASUREMENT**
  - a. EC officials will conduct random measurement of ponies during the competition year, regardless of whether or not a pony has a permanent measurement card.
  - b. Ponies six years and over that have been officially measured in this process will be issued a measurement card that is valid for three years. The first three-year cards will be issued in 2009.
  - c. Ponies under six years of age must be measured annually and will be issued a temporary measurement form. (See Section A, General Regulations, Article A1104)
  - d. All ponies entered in a national final (e.g. The Royal Horse Show) will be measured at that competition if they do not have a valid current measurement card. To be exempt from measurement at the final, the owner must present the current measurement card. No measurement card dated earlier than 2009 will be accepted.
  - e. Ponies may be measured barefoot or shod. If shod, the depth of the shoe shall be noted on the measurement page and subtracted from the height. (See A1109.2)
34. **Jumper Tack: G603**
35. Standing martingales and draw reins secured at the neck will be permitted in jumper classes where the height of the Fences does not exceed 1.15 meters, except that draw reins are not permissible in Junior, Amateur, Non-Pro or Pony divisions. Sheepskins may be used on each cheek piece of the bridle providing the sheepskin does not exceed 3 cm in diameter measured from the horse's face.
36. Jumper Medal, martingales are not to be worn for the flat phase (G1209)

### Hunter Divisions

Each hunter division will comprise 3 classes, the first two classes will be ridden over a course of hunter jumps, the third class will be under saddle class. Horses must compete in and complete one over fence class to be eligible for the under saddle class.

### Hack Division

The hack division will comprise three classes as follows:

**Pleasure Horse:** Head well shaped, attractive and proportionate; mane may be roached; natural (not set) tail, strong well shaped neck with good length of rein; good sloping shoulder; medium high withers the same height as the croup; chest indicative of strength; sloping pasterns of good length, feet of proportionate size. Pleasure horse must present an appearance of overall substance with refinement. Soundness is required and Blemishes may be penalized. Braiding of the mane and tail is optional.

**Gaits:** Flat footed walk, normal trot and easy canter, NOT to gallop, light contact to be maintained.

**To be Judged:** 45% on performance, 40% on manners and 15% confirmation.

**Road Hack:** Head well-shaped, attractive and proportionate; mane may be roached; natural (not set) tail; strong well-shaped neck with good length of rein; good strong sloping shoulders; medium high withers the same height as the croup; chest indicative of strength; moderately muscled forearm; back well proportioned with height, powerful across the loin; good depth of girth, well shaped proportionate quarters showing strength; sloping pasterns of good length, feet of proportionate size. Road hack must present an appearance of overall substance with

refinement. Soundness is required and blemishes may be penalized. Braiding mane and tail is optional.

**Gaits** The walk; straight, 4 beat, flat footed at medium contact. The trot: straight and true, may be required as follows: 1) normal on light on medium contact; 2) Strong trot. The canter: normal on light to medium contact. Hand gallop under control.

**To be Judged:** 55% performance; 20% substance, 15% confirmation and 10% manners.

**Show hack;** Head neat, finely drawn and elegant. Mane must not be roached and may be braided, neck of sufficient length with a trim throat latch, neck to blend into shoulders which are medium width and not too heavily muscled; medium high and well-defined with the same height as the croup; chest well-developed but in proportion; forearm not too heavily muscled; back moderately short but well proportioned with height; moderately deep girth and well shaped proportionate quarters; sloping pasterns of good length; feet of proportionate size. Show hack must have vitality. Animation, presence, balance and clean fine limbs showing supreme quality. Soundness is required and blemishes may be penalized. Braiding of mane and tail is optional.

**Gaits:** the walk; straight, 4 beat flat footed. The trot free light and crisp, may be required as follows: 1) on contact in a more upright frame. 2) collected with rider sitting. 3) extended-on contact-medium speed with legs moving forward with impulsion and rider posting or sitting. The canter: 1) collected, 2) normal, 3) extended. Hand gallop under control.

**To be Judged:** 55% performance; 20% quality, 15% conformation and 10% manners.

### **3' Hunter Medal (90 cm)**

Open to all junior and amateur riders. Ponies may be entered but height and lines will not be adjusted. Hunter tack to be used. To be judged as a Horsemanship Medal Class. There will be 2 Tests within the course. The top 7 riders will qualify to compete in this class at the last show of the season.

### **3'3" Jumper Medal (100 cm)**

Open to Junior and Amateur riders only. Competitors in Children's Hunter and Adult Amateur Hunter may show. Jumper Tack rules apply and must remain the same for both phases. The over fences phase will be judged under Table 'A' rules over a course of at least 9 jumps including at least one double combination and two other spread fences, liverpools are optional, in addition to being judged on seat, hand, guidance and control of the horse. The top seven riders over fences will be called back to ride off on the flat. Judges may require additional tests. To be judged 60% over fences and 40% on the flat.

### **Clear Round Jumper**

1 class maximum of 3'0" (90 cm). There will not be a jump off. Competitors with a clear round will be awarded a ribbon.

### **Child Adult Jumper Division**

Open to Junior and Amateur riders only. Competitors in Children's Hunter and Adult Amateur Hunter may show in this division. Maximum Height 3'3". The division will comprise 3 classes.

### **Trillium Jumper**

Competitors in Children's Hunter and Adult Amateur Hunter divisions may show in this division. Maximum height 3'9".

The division will comprise 3 classes.
