The equitation over fence class will have the top 8 back to flat. Top 4 to jump. The 3' hunter class will become a hunter classic with top 8 to do a second round. And providing we have enough horses we will have a 3' jumper class and a 3' jumper medal. Top 6 to flat and top 3 to jump. Program enclosed. Cost \$80.00 plus HST. Schooling horse rental is included for the day. There is something for everyone. Check with your instructor to see what is for you. Book your school horse through Emily.


